You are kindly invited to participate, offer paper for oral or poster presentation for the Eucarpia Cereal Section Conference, 2023. Normal presentations are 15 minutes long including questions and remarks. The poster presenters are asked to send their poster by email attachment. Posters will be presented on an electronic wall-poster display, and/or 4 minutes flash presentation. There will not be classical printed poster session. You are invited to register and submit your abstract online http://cerealszeged2023.eu. One Main Author is allowed to send only one presentation. The submitted abstract will be revised by the Scientific Committee and a confirmation message on the mode of presentation will be sent on your email. A book of abstracts including invited papers and all accepted offered papers (both oral and poster presentations) will be available to the participants. Selected papers planned to be edited after the Conference and issued by a Cereal Research Communication Special Issue.

Deadline for registration and abstract submission: March 31, 2023. http://cerealszeged2023.eu
The Scientific Committee will decide on oral and poster contributions based on the abstract theme and level. Authors will be informed the status of their presentation preferably by April 15 but not later than April 25, 2023. An electric Book of Abstracts will be available to the Participants.

Hotels and traffic to (and within) Szeged

For accommodation, the organizers offer to choose Hunguest Hotel Forrás (conference venue) or the Hotel Tisza Sport for your stay Both hotels are at the left side of the river Tisza and very close to each other. However, you may choose and book any other Hotel in Szeged i.e. Art Hotel, Hotel Novotel, or the historical Hotel Tisza in downtown. Downtown (centrum) is also close to the venue — only 2 km. Because there are other international and national events in that period in Szeged, do your booking in time and use in your booking "Cereal Conference" keyword when you order your accommodation. From Budapest Airport, there is a good bus-to-train and a very convenient train service to Szeged. Trains depart hourly from the Airport to Szeged. Check here: Budapest Airport (BUD) to Szeged
